Petition to the European Parliament and African leaders

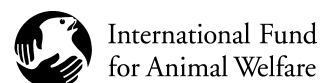

We ask that African leaders ensure that wildlife protection laws are enforced and that wildlife resources are used sustainably for future generations.

We ask that our representatives in government (both national and European Union) use their offices to ensure that leaders of African countries are strongly encouraged and supported in their efforts to eliminate the illegal bushmeat trade. We ask that no aid is directed to projects that will assist, directly or indirectly, the illegal sector of the commercial bushmeat trade, and that aid is made available for the enforcement of wildlife laws and the sustainable management of wildlife resources
